



## **TERRITORIAL SCOPE**

- Islands less than 150 km<sup>2</sup>
  - No bridge, cut off from the continent at low tide
  - Inhabited or not
- Protected or not
- In any sea







### **Common vision on sustainable tourism**



#### Islands:

Kerkennah (Tunisia), Municipality of Kerkennah
Brownsea (UK), National Trust
Lastovo (Croatia), Nature Park Lastovo
Paros (Greece), FOTOESSA

#### Action plan

- identify, measure and manage the impacts of tourism, using an impact management framework and guidelines;
- identify 4-5 concrete actions;
- to ultimately develop a more sustainable tourism model.

## Women on islands, leaders of sustainable tourism

#### **Pilot actions led by women**

**Lastovo**: enhancing olive oil production by the family organisation *OPG Trojkovic,* as a local traditional product for visitors to discover.

**Kerkennah**: promote the re-use of green waste (date palm leaves) by women to create traditional and non-traditional objects for visitors + promote the preservation of a local know-how.

**Brownsea**: contribute to enhancing local food procurement on the island for visitors and inhabitants, in particular by including locally sourced fish in the menus for visitors.

**Paros**: support the association of local women of Paros to create a guided tour on Paros to discover one of the oldest traditions of the island, the making of wine and local spirits.

## **Project results**



Contribution to a more sustainable tourism industry with a better gender balance in leadership roles.



New tourism products have more positive impacts on the environment. They contribute to diversify the tourist offer and reduce dependence on seasonal tourism.



Enhanced inter-island collaboration and good practices exchange, which contribute to reducing the isolation of these territories.
